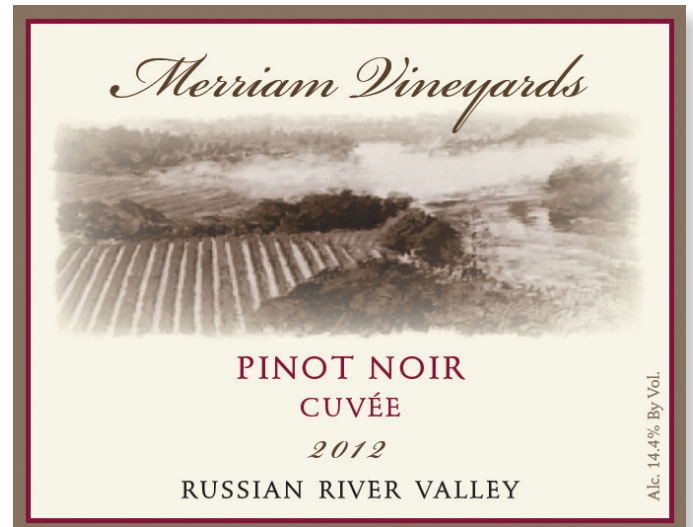

Cuvée is a blend of four different clones: 667, 777, 23 and 115. These clones were planted in 2009 on our winery site located on Los Amigos Rd., Healdsburg, Sonoma County in the Russian River Valley. This four acre vineyard is farmed organically and certified CCOF.

Tasting Notes

In the glass, brilliant dark red hues, aromatic notes of mocha espresso and dark berry fruit - boysenberry and cranberry. Medium body with notes of dark cherry, caramel and white mushrooms. Bright acidity and a creaminess on the finish.
