

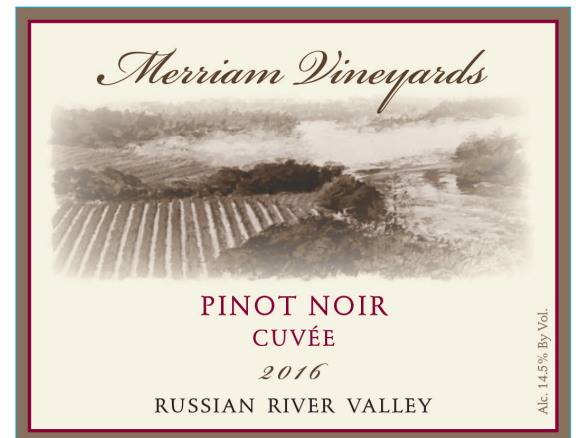
PINOT NOIR CUVÉE

Vineyard

Cuvée is a blend of four different clones: 115, Pomard, 777 and 667. Each clone is harvested, fermented and aged separately before the final blend is established. These clones were planted in 2009 on our winery site located on Los Amigos Road, Healdsburg, Sonoma County in the Russian River Valley. This four acre vineyard is farmed organically and certified CCOF.

Tasting Notes

Classic color, bright light purple with Garnet at the edge. Brilliant aromas of cherry, violet, and spice. Dark cherry, vanilla and white mushrooms. Bright acidity, and long creaminess on the finish. Our Pinot Noir is a classic Russian River profile wine.
