VINEYARD

Produced and bottled by Merriam Vineyards, this Russian River Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is made up of a base of Merriam's estate grown fruit, combined with grapes sourced from nearby vineyards. The Russian River Valley is located in Northern Sonoma County and is comprised of 15,000 vineyard acres with around 70 wineries. Cool evenings, and warm sunny days, result in wines that are well structured, balanced and contain the ideal acidity to pair exceptionally well with food.

TASTING NOTES

A dynamically deep ruby Cabernet Sauvignon with purple hues that mimic the structured full body of the wine. On the nose aromas of blackberry, dark cherry, and pyrazines engulf the senses with underlining notes of lavender, cinnamon bark, and thyme. On the palate top notes of bramble, cranberry, and green bell pepper. The wine finishes with structure tannins and the lingering essence of paprika and cumin.
