VINEYARD

Produced and bottled by Merriam Vineyards, this Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is made up of a base of Merriam's estate grown fruit, combined with grapes sourced from nearby vineyards. The Russian River Valley is located in Northern Sonoma County and is comprised of 15,000 vineyard acres with around 70 wineries. Cool evenings, and warm sunny days, result in wines that are well structured, balanced and contain the ideal acidity to pair exceptionally well with food.

TASTING NOTES

A medium bodied Russian River Valley Pinot Noir that can easily be paired with food or stand on its own. Top notes of blueberry pie and pomegranate juice swirl in the glass, met with traces of pink rose petal and brown sugar on the nose. Soft and elegant tannins follow on the palate with complimentary notes of berry bramble, brown leather, and cinnamon bark.
