VINEYARD

Produced and bottled by Merriam Vineyards, this Russian River Valley Chardonnay is made up of Merriam's estate grown fruit, and vineyards. The Russian River Valley is located in Northern Sonoma County and is comprised of 15,000 vineyard acres with around 70 wineries. Cool evenings, and warm sunny days, result in wines that are well structured, balanced and contain the ideal acidity to pair exceptionally well with food.

TASTING NOTES

This Chardonnay shows a brilliant balance and elegance with its richly textured mouthfeel combined with delectable flavors of white peach, melon, ripe grapefruit, with hints of creamy oak and butterscotch. There is a lovely perfume of lychee fruit, a nutty component and a hint of lemon peel. This fuller bodied wine may be enjoyed with wild mushroom risotto and should be consumed in its youth.
