VINEYARD

Produced and bottled by Merriam Vineyards, this Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is made up of a base of Merriam's estate grown fruit, combined with grapes sourced from nearby vineyards. The Russian River Valley is located in Northern Sonoma County and is comprised of 15,000 vineyard acres with around 70 wineries. Cool evenings, and warm sunny days, result in wines that are well structured, balanced and contain the ideal acidity to pair exceptionally well with food.

TASTING NOTES

This medium-bodied Pinot Noir shows the bright and lively acidity that is classic of its home in the Russian River Valley. Aromas and flavors of cranberry, raspberry, red cherry, blueberry and black plum are pronounced and enticing. This richly textured wine is matched with a beautiful structure and lingering finish of ripe red berries and a hint of spice.
