VINEYARD

Produced and bottled by Merriam Vineyards, this Russian River Valley Sauvignon Blanc is made up of Merriam's estate grown fruit, and vineyards. The Russian River Valley is located in Northern Sonoma County and is comprised of 15,000 vineyard acres with around 70 wineries. Cool evenings, and warm sunny days, result in wines that are well structured, balanced and contain the ideal acidity to pair exceptionally well with food.

TASTING NOTES

This dry style Sauvignon Blanc is beautifully crisp, refreshing and pure. Its high acidity excites the taste buds and is complemented by the pronounced aromatics and flavors of tropical fruit (pineapple, lychee fruit, ripe peach, nectarine and delicately layered with notes of hibiscus and honeysuckle.
