Produced and bottled by Merriam Vineyards, this Russian River Valley Chardonnay is made up of Merriam's estate grown fruit, and vineyards. The Russian River Valley is located in Northern Sonoma County and is comprised of 15,000 vineyard acres with around 70 wineries. Cool evenings, and warm sunny days, result in wines that are well structured, balanced and contain the ideal acidity to pair exceptionally well with food.

TASTING NOTES

This Chardonnay opens with a vibrant bouquet of lemon zest, Gravenstein apple, and ripe Bartlett pear. The palate is both crisp and creamy, offering a lively mouthfeel that dances across the tongue with notes of pineapple and melon.
