Produced and bottled by Merriam Vineyards, this Russian River Valley Rosé of Pinot Noir is made up of a base of Merriam's estate grown fruit, combined with grapes sourced from nearby vineyards. The Russian River Valley is located in Northern Sonoma County and is comprised of 15,000 vineyard acres with around 70 wineries. Cool evenings, and warm sunny days, result in wines that are well structured, balanced and contain the ideal acidity to pair exceptionally well with food.

TASTING NOTES

This Rosé of Pinot Noir is beautifully delicate and refreshing. It opens with an inviting bouquet of hibiscus and fresh watermelon, offering a fragrant floral lift complemented by juicy, sun-ripened fruit. On the palate, bright rhubarb and ripe strawberry take the lead striking a perfect balance. Lively acidity carries through to a crisp, elegant finish, with a lingering touch of minerality.
